## Why Choose a Celebrant?

A celebrant ceremony gives you complete freedom, is all about **you**, telling your story, exchanging vows and the atmosphere you wish to create. My role is to shape a ceremony that feels personal, meaningful, and memorable. However, it is not a legal marriage. You will need to complete the legal registration separately at your local Register Office, with a short service, you can also have a Registrar attend your venue before the celebrant-led ceremony begins, then enjoy **your** personalised celebrant ceremony with all your guests present.

### A note on legalities

Most couples complete the legal formality quietly at a register office a short, simple appointment and then celebrate with the ceremony that truly matters to them. I will guide you through exactly how this works. It is far more straightforward than you might think.

- ♥ Space for family and friends to take a meaningful role
- ♥ Music that moves you, from any genre you love.
- ♥ A closing that sends your guests away with exactly the right feeling

## Vow Renewals

A vow renewal is a chance to pause, look at each other, and say “I still choose you” in front of the people who matter most. Whether you are marking a milestone anniversary, celebrating after a difficult chapter, or simply wanting to do things with more meaning than you did the first time, a vow renewal can be exactly what you need it to be.

There are no rules, no formalities, and no fixed format. Just you, your story, and the words that feel true.

## How It Works

- 1. Get in touch** A relaxed, no-obligation chat to discuss ideas and see if I am the right person for your ceremony.
- 2. Getting to know you** A detailed questionnaire and planning meeting to explore your ideas, wishes and vision. This is where the magic starts.
- 3. I write your ceremony** A full script crafted around everything I have discovered about you. Shared well in advance for your thoughts.
- 4. We refine it together** Changes are always welcome. This is your ceremony and it should feel exactly right.
- 5. Your day** I arrive early, handle everything with care, and hold the ceremony beautifully so you can simply be present for every moment and have a memorable day to talk about and reflect on forever.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### How far in advance should I book?

As early as you can, popular dates fill up quickly. For weddings I would recommend booking at least 12 months ahead if possible, though I will always do my best to accommodate shorter timescales.

### Can the ceremony be held anywhere?

Virtually Yes - that is one of the great joys of working with a celebrant. Gardens, woodlands, village halls: if it matters to you, it matters to me. Always check with your venue about any restrictions on sound, open flames or outdoor ceremonies.

### Will my ceremony be legally binding?

Currently in the UK, celebrant ceremonies are not legally recognised in the same way as those conducted by a registrar. Many couples choose to have a short, quiet legal appointment at a register office and then celebrate with a full, meaningful ceremony with me. I will guide you through this, as it is simpler than it sounds and very widely done.

### Can I write my own vows?

Absolutely and I would love to help you. I can offer prompts, guidance and a gentle edit so your words sound exactly as you intend when spoken aloud. Or if you would prefer, I can write your vows for you entirely.

### How involved can you be in the planning?

As involved as you would like. Some couples arrive with a clear vision; others want to explore ideas together. I genuinely love the creative process and will happily brainstorm, suggest, guide and inspire as much or as little as you need.

### What happens if you are ill on the day?

I have a network of trusted fellow celebrants who I would call on in an emergency. I always have a contingency plan and your ceremony will never be left without cover.

### Do you travel outside Bedfordshire?

Yes, I cover Hertfordshire and the surrounding counties, and I am always happy to discuss travel further afield.

### How long is a ceremony?

Most ceremonies run between 20 and 45 minutes, though this is entirely flexible. We will agree the right length for your day together.
